



Writing a Legal Disclaimer for Your Business' Facebook Fan Page

1. Put the link of your blog disclaimer at the top part of your Facebook fan page. Your disclaimer must be instantly visible to any person visiting this social media platform.
2. Don't forget to include your contact details in your disclaimer--your phone number, email address, address and name, so third parties can easily contact you.
3. Mention that the details provided on the Facebook fan page by third parties are not your responsibility, and that any person posting content on this platform is solely responsible for their own views.
4. Disclaim all of the rights to the provided information within your fan page. Any descriptions, pictures or other details related to your page's subject may be a property of a third-party platform. In order to avoid liability, mention that you are hosting the content only as a normal fan.
5. Tell your visitors to respect owner's rights. Tell them to only post content which is not protected under any copyright law.
